LIFT, CLEAN AND PLACE

Only when the Club posts you can Lift, Clean and Place your ball, please follow this guideline:

Lift, Clean and Place is a Local Rule ; not found in the USGA Rules & Definitions as an official Rule

1. can only be applied on the fairway (and in our club) on in the rough
2. you must mark your ball before you pick it up
3. you can clean your ball before placing (putting it) back down on the fairway to a “slightly” better lie
 - a. we will allow you to lift, clean and place in the rough as well in this Local Rule
4. You cannot use this Local Rule in a Hazard, in a Bunker or on the Green

Even though we can use this “Local Rule - Appendix” for each ball in a fairway or in the rough, please be judicious (thoughtful) not to pick up every and each of your balls that you feel need cleaning. Some slight dirt and mud is normal in golf. I ask for your careful consideration to maintain a good pace of play and not abuse the Committee’s rule for the day. Not every ball needs to be cleaned
